## USBC-HDMI Adapter

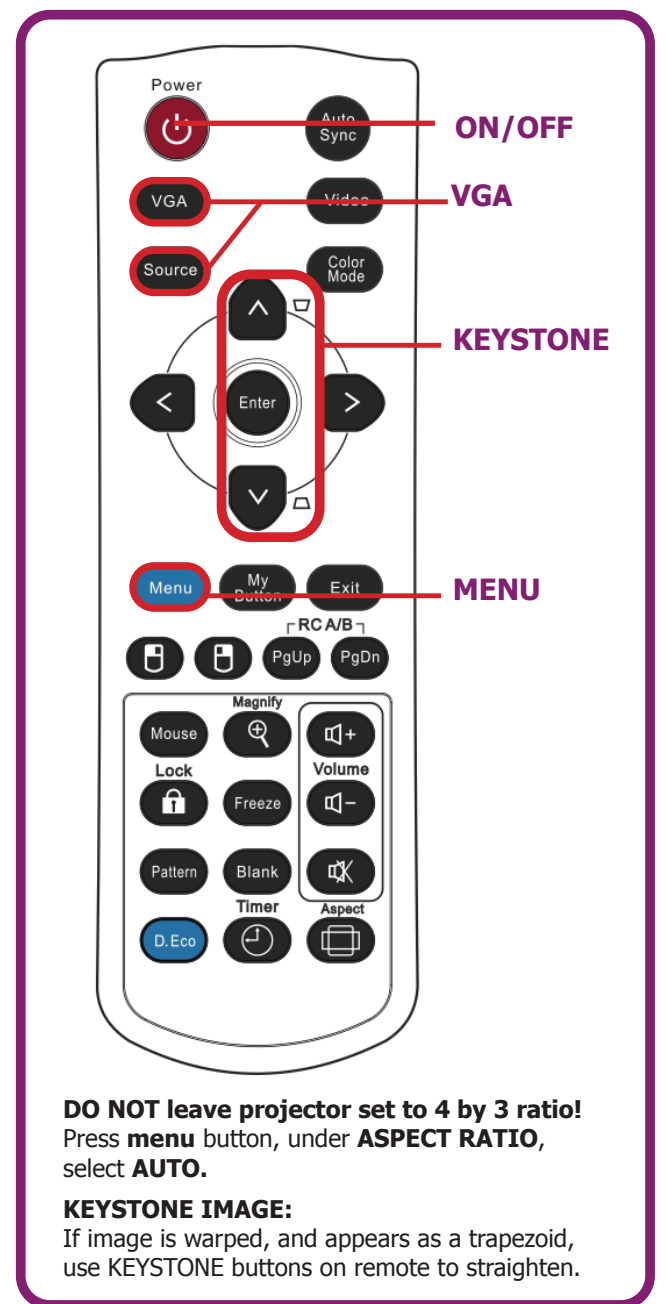
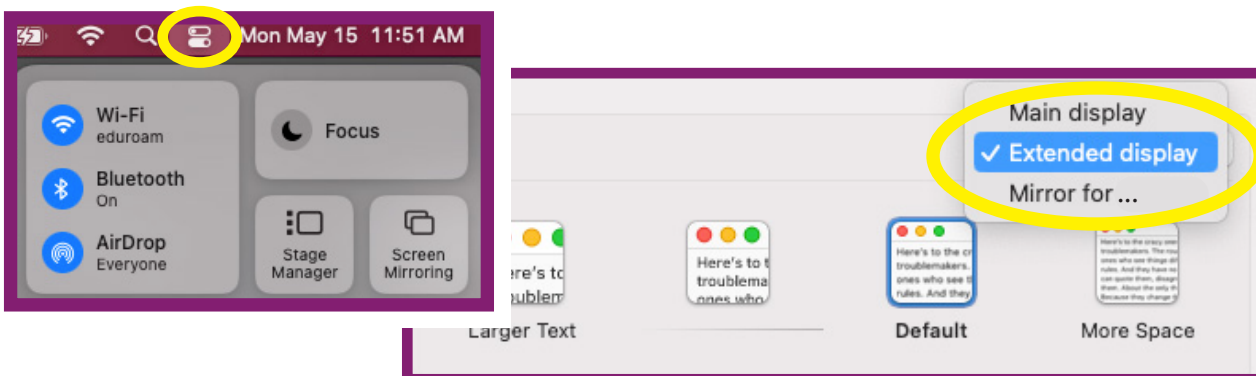


## 1. Check Cable Connections

- Make sure all cables and adapters are firmly connected.
- If you don't see an image, or it is very distorted, detach and re-attach the adapter. Display resolution details are in **Step 2**.

## 2. Projector Settings

- Turn **on** the iMac first
- Turn **on** the projector using the remote. (point remote to projection wall)
- Set projector input to **HDMI** with **SOURCE** button on remote.
- To **mirror** or **extend** your image, click the **Control Centre Button** on the top right of screen. Select **Screen Mirroring** and then **Display Settings**.

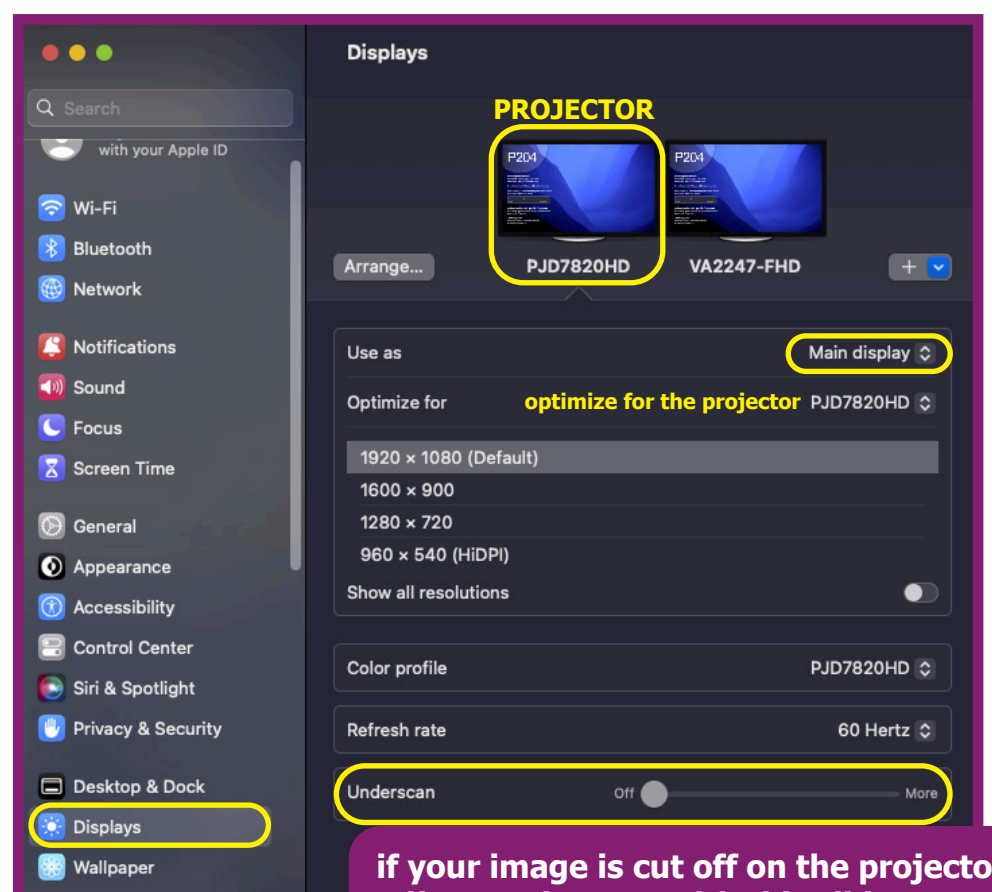
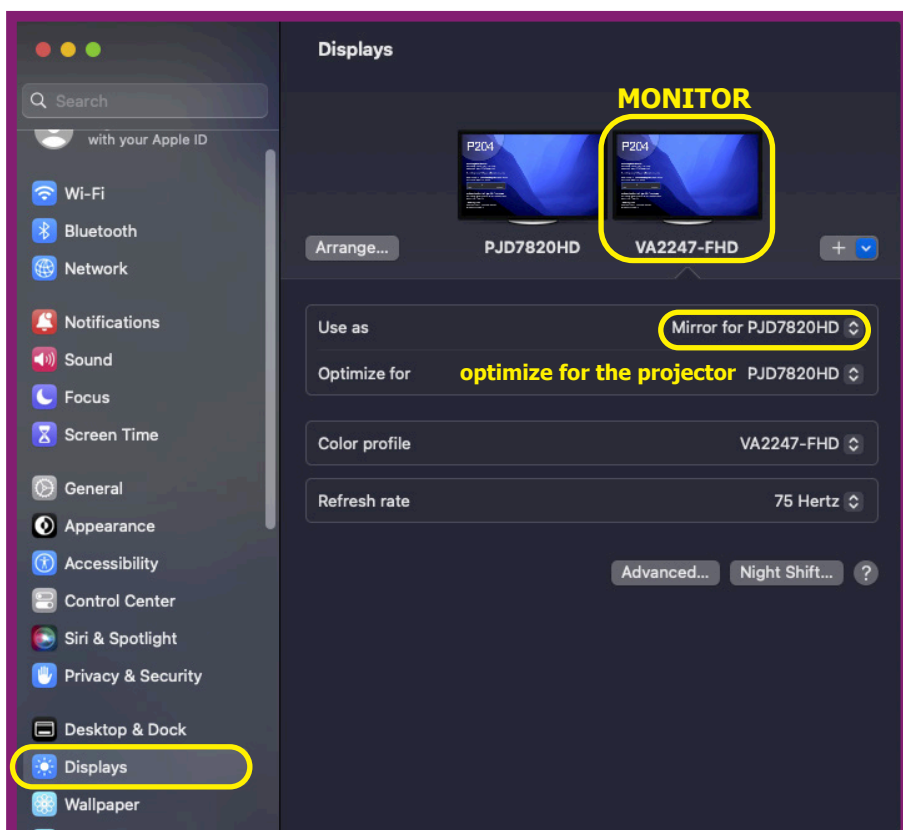


**DO NOT** leave projector set to 4 by 3 ratio! Press **menu** button, under **ASPECT RATIO**, select **AUTO**.

**KEYSTONE IMAGE:** If image is warped, and appears as a trapezoid, use **KEYSTONE** buttons on remote to straighten.

## 3. Resolution Settings

- To adjust resolution, open **System Settings**, and go to **Displays**
- Set resolution for **monitor** and **projector** as shown below
