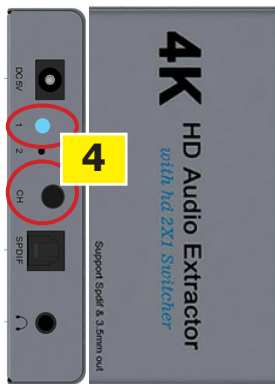
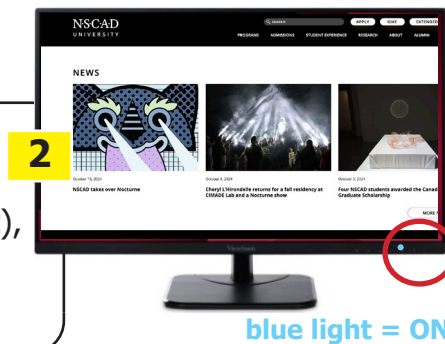


# P207 MAC MINI

## Mac Mini, Monitor & Projection

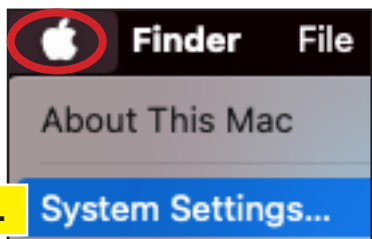


1. Turn **Mac Mini** on if necessary.
2. If **monitor** is off (no signal/no **blue light**), press power button on the back right.
3. Turn **projector** on.

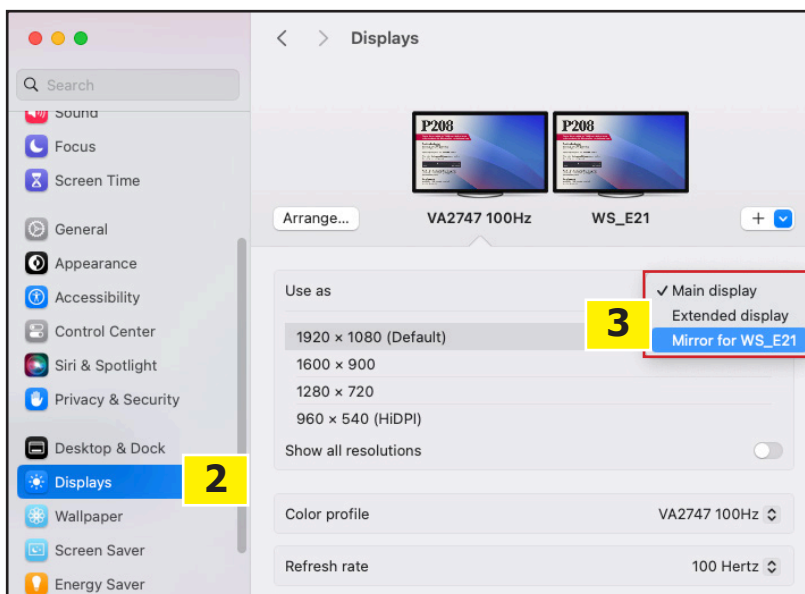


4. **No signal?** On the **HDMI SWITCHER**, use **Channel 1 for Mac Mini**. Press the **Channel Button** on the left side of the switcher to enable projection & audio from the Mac Mini.  
\*\* **Channel 1** should **light up blue!**

## Set Mirror or Extended Mode for projector



1. Go to **System Settings** from **Apple Menu**.
2. Under **Displays** go to **Use As** pulldown.
3. Select **Mirror for WS\_E21** or **Extended Display**.



Select **Mirror** for **WS\_E21** to mirror display.

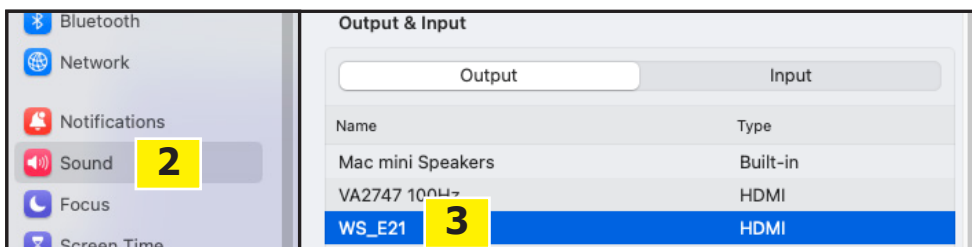
Select **Extended display** to extend display.

## Audio thru Logitech Speakers



green light = ON

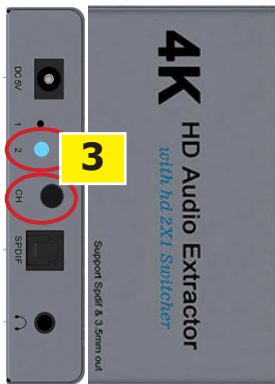
1. Turn on **speakers** with dial, **green light** will be lit.
2. In **System Settings** go to **Sound**.
3. Under **Output** select **WS\_E21**. Use speaker dial to adjust volume levels.

## Laptop & Projection

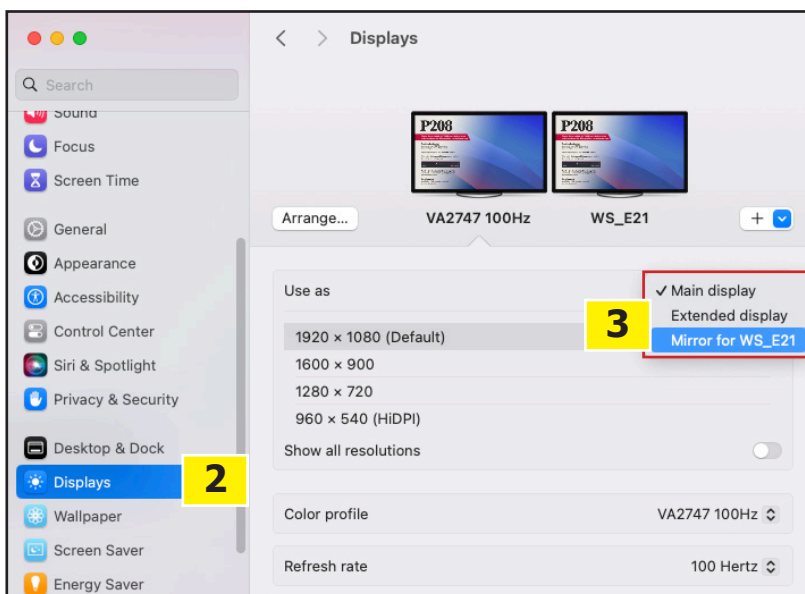
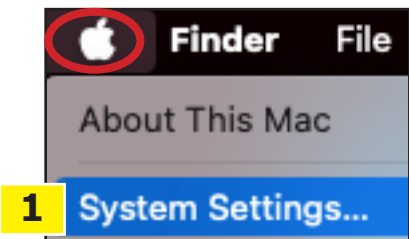
1. Turn **Laptop** on if necessary and connect HDMI/USBC cable.
2. Turn **projector** on.



3. No signal? On the **HDMI SWITCHER**, use **Channel 2 for Laptop**. Press the **Channel Button** on the left side of the switcher to enable projection & audio from the Laptop.  
\*\* Channel 2 should **light up blue!**

## Set Mirror or Extended Mode for projector

1. Go to **System Settings** from **Apple Menu**.
2. Under **Displays** go to **Use As** pulldown.
3. Select **Mirror for WS\_E21** or **Extended Display**.



Select **Mirror** for WS\_E21 to mirror display.

Select **Extended display** to extend display.

## Audio thru Logitech Speakers

1. Turn on **speakers** with dial, **green light** will be lit.
2. In **System Settings** go to **Sound**.
